“In 1995, my father, Bill Wathall, passed away aged just 62. He had spent over 40 years as a funeral director, advising families about their loved ones funeral, and giving hundreds of talks to local groups suggesting that the best thing to do was to ‘make your funeral wishes known’.

When he died, my family discovered that the subject of his funeral had not been discussed with any of us, even after working alongside him for over 10 years. We all assumed that someone else had all the information.

This made an already tragic situation even worse. We had to establish what he would have wanted, whilst still mourning his loss too. If I can offer just a single piece of advice, based not only on personal experience, but also on the many times we’ve had similar situations with the families we help, it would be to make your funeral wishes known now, for the benefit of your family and friends and your own peace of mind.


